Select classes from the Master Schedule or as listed in Skyward under "Arena Scheduling." Consider classes from other required categories, such as Art, CTE, or Digital Studies. Other classes may include World Languages or Seminary. Write in additional class choices.

If you wish to take Seminary, don't forget to add it as one of your eight periods. Year-long classes should be kept the same period throughout the year whenever possible.
